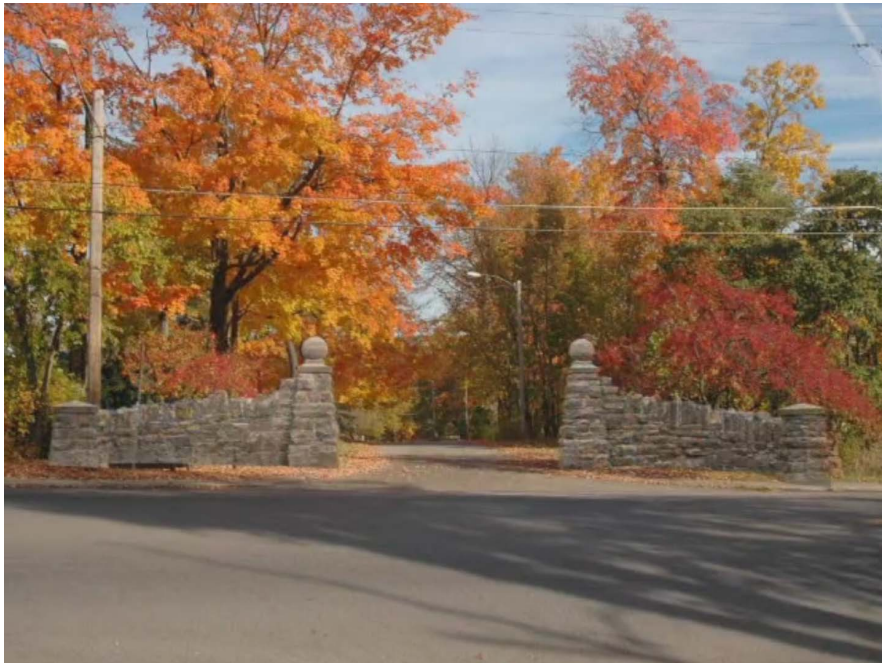


Video: History of North Lake Park in Mansfield once known as Luna Park
